The council's Children's Services, the Health Service, the Police, Voluntary Sector and many others are committed to working together to ensure we achieve these aims. We offer services and support for children and young people between the ages of 0-19, and older in some cases, to help them reach their full potential.

Something for all the family

For young families we can provide comprehensive information on registered childcare, including child minders, nurseries and play groups.

For children of school age we offer out of school clubs, homework clubs, holiday schemes and school pick-ups. For parents we offer information about schools and admissions to primary and secondary schools. There are also allowances such as the Education Maintenance Allowance.

There are a wide range of activities on offer including youth clubs and projects where young people can meet with friends and make new ones. There are also Children's Centres for 0 to 5 years olds and their families. Plus Play and Youth Centres which offer everything to keep children and young people entertained and busy.
