Bolton has over 3000 acres of parks, playgrounds, open spaces, golf courses and outdoor sports facilities. The town also boasts 130 children's play areas, 70 soccer pitches and numerous recreation grounds for all to enjoy. We try and ensure that these areas are safe for you and your family to use. Sports facilities can be found in most parks and you can hire any of the sporting facilities to take part in organised sports like football or rounders.

and safer Bolton

Each year we set out a programme for improving and maintaining Bolton's roads and we have an ongoing calendar of repairs. In addition we respond to issues such as icy roads, snow clearance, keeping verges clear and dealing with potholes to make sure that Bolton's roads are safer for everyone. We also inspect street lights at regular intervals but if you do notice any problems please let us know.

Anti-social behaviour such as noise, criminal damage, uncontrolled pets and graffiti can impact on people's lives. There are various organisations and community groups helping us to tackle this.

Our youth offending team are continually working to help prevent young people from breaking the law and support young people who are in trouble as well as working with parents and supporting victims of crime.



These are all important priorities for the council. We are working closely with partners to prevent incidents, change behaviour and support communities to make Bolton a cleaner, greener and safer place to live, work, invest and visit.
