The Council proposes to create and/or amend traffic orders as detailed within this document.

Statement of reasons

1. A series of traffic calming measures have recently been introduced in the area of Bradford Street to address the number of accidents which have occurred in this area. An unforeseen consequence of these measures has been the increased use of Back Bradford Street East in an attempt to jump traffic queues (rat-running).

THE BOLTON (BACK BRADFORD STREET EAST, BOLTON) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC) (EXPERIMENTAL) (NO.4) ORDER 2018

The Borough Council of Bolton has made an Order under Sections 9, 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic Act 1984. The effect of the Orders which will be operative from 30 March 2018, and will be in operation for an experimental period of 18 months will be as follows:

One Way Traffic:

Back Bradford Street East, from its junction with Castle Street to its junction with Radcliffe Road.
Permitted Direction of Travel south west to north east only.

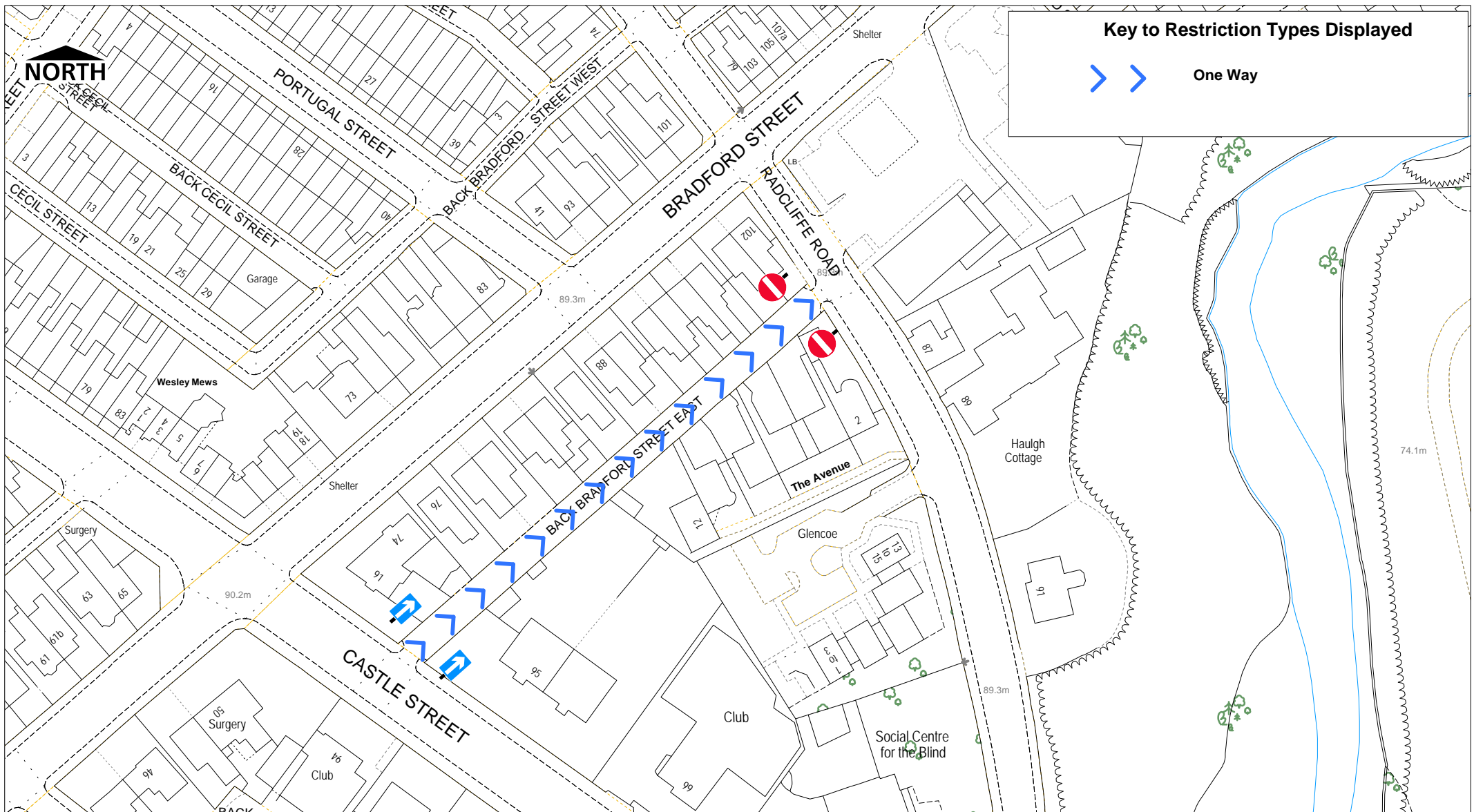

**THE BOLTON (BACK BRADFORD STREET EAST, BOLTON) (ONE WAY TRAFFIC)
(EXPERIMENTAL) (NO.04) ORDER 2018**

The Borough Council of Bolton, in exercise of their powers under Sections 9, 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984 and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Greater Manchester Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. In this Order:

“Vehicle” has the same meaning as defined in Section 1 (1B) of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994 or any other vehicle unless specifically exempted by the provisions of the Order.

2. For the avoidance of doubt, where any length of road is described within the Schedule to this Order, that restriction (unless stated to the contrary within the Schedule to this Order) shall apply to the whole width of the road so described in those said lengths of road.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable or a police community support officer in uniform, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, in a direction other than that specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order.
4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause an ambulance, police vehicle, fire engine, or any vehicle used in the service of a fire and rescue authority or police force, to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, during an emergency.
5. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any other Order relating to the one way movement of traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order, this Order shall prevail.
6. The Order will become operative on the 30th March 2018 and may be cited as The Bolton (Back Bradford Street East, Bolton) (One Way Traffic) (Experimental) (No.04) Order 2018
