RENOVATION OF LOCAL NATURE RESERVES

The Town Council recognises the importance of public green spaces and is donating £7,000 towards the cost of repairs to Local Nature Reserves in Westhoughton and Bolton Council is arranging the work.

GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

The Town Council must comply with GDPR, which came into effect on 25th May, 2018.
