Planning and Building Control applications

Our core data protection obligations and commitments are set out in the council's **primary** privacy notice at www.bolton.gov.uk

This notice provides additional privacy information for:

- Members of the public look to use the planning and building control service
- Professional bodies engaging with the service

It describes how we collect, use and share personal information about you

- In relation to planning and building control applications
- the types of personal information we need to process, including information the law describes as 'special' because of its sensitivity

It is important that you read this notice, together with any other privacy information we may provide on specific occasions when we are collecting or processing personal information about you, so that you are aware of how and why we are using such information.

The information collected and held will vary dependent on the service used.

Purpose(s)

We collect your personal information for the following purpose(s):

- To validate and register the planning and building control applications and appeals in adherence with its statutory obligations
- Any enforcement actions required
- To comply with the statutory requirement of the Building Act 1984

Categories of personal data

In order to carry out these purposes we collect and obtain:

- Basic details about you such as name, address, telephone number, email address.
- Contact we have had with you, such as any correspondence

Legal basis for processing

The legal basis for processing your personal information is:

- you, or your legal representative, have given consent
- statutory duty under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990
- Statutory requirement under The Building Act 1984
- in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority

If you fail to provide certain information when requested, Bolton Council may be unable to process the application.

Information sharing/recipients

We may share personal information about you with the following types of organisations:

- Teams within the Council in order to provide our services
- Third parties when required to do so e.g. other statutory consultees such as the Highways Agency, Natural England Environmental Agency and Building Control
- Agencies working on behalf of you with your consent
- The application will be available on the public register, however parts of the personal information will be redacted where possible e.g. telephone number (planning applications)
- When required by law to prevent or detect crime or to protect public fund

Automated Decisions

For this service:

- All the decisions we make about you involve human intervention

Data retention/criteria

We will only keep your personal information for as long as the law specifies or where the law does not specify this, for the length of time determined by our business requirements.

Rights of individuals

You may exercise the rights listed below in relation to the council's use of your personal information.
