NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICING TEAM VEHICLE

The Town Council has funded a hire car to be used as a Neighbourhood Policing Team Vehicle, for 12 months, at a cost of £5,000.

PLANTERS ON MARKET STREET

The Town Council will ensure that Market Street is bright and welcoming in the summer months by funding the plants for the planters and the ongoing maintenance, plus the winter/spring bedding plants at a cost of £3,201.
