PRETORIA PIT DISASTER ANNIVERSARY

Thursday, 21st December, 2017 is the 107th anniversary of the Pretoria Pit Disaster, in which 344 men and boys lost their lives and the Town Council has organised two services of Remembrance:

At 7.40 a.m., at the Pretoria Pit Disaster Centenary Memorial, Ditchfield Garden, Market Street, Westhoughton, a short Service of Remembrance, with maroons fired at 7.50 a.m., which was the time of the explosion at the Pretoria Pit.

At 10.00 a.m., at the Parish Church of St Bartholomew, the usual Service of Remembrance will take place, followed by the laying of floral tributes at the Pretoria Monument in the churchyard.

CIVIC MEDAL & THE HAROLD DANIELS MEMORAL TROPHY

Members of the public are invited to write to the Town Council with nominations for a Civic Medal, and the Harold Daniels Memorial trophy which will be kept for one year. Nominees must have provided over 20 years service to Westhoughton in any field. They do not have to be residents of Westhoughton to qualify and nominations will be accepted for individuals who have been previously nominated but have not yet received an award. Nominations, giving as much detail as possible, should be sent to the Town Clerk by Monday, 4th December, 2017.

YOUNG CITIZEN OF THE YEAR **AWARDS**

Members of the public are invited to write to the Town Council with nominations for Young Citizen of the Year Awards. Nominees must be under 30 years of age inclusive and have provided service to Westhoughton in any field. They do not have to be residents of Westhoughton to qualify. Nominations, giving as much detail as possible, should be sent to the Town Clerk by Monday, 4th December, 2017.

ENVIRONMENTAL AWARD

Members of the public are invited to nominate an individual, voluntary group, school, church or business which enhances an area of Westhoughton by organising and working on environmental initiatives such as planting, weeding, tidying, litter picking etc. Nominations, giving as much detail as possible, should be sent to the Town Clerk by Monday, 4th December, 2017.

REMEMBRANCE DAY PARADE

On Remembrance Sunday, 12th November, 2017, townspeople are invited to attend the Remembrance Day Service and Parade. The Parade will assemble outside the St Bartholomew's Primary School yard, The Fairways, Westhoughton at 9.20 a.m. and will depart at 9.40 a.m., for a service at the Parish Church of St Bartholomew at 10.00 a.m., followed by a short Service of Remembrance and the wreath laying at the War Memorial, and a Parade.

COMMUNITY CAROL SERVICE

On Friday, 24th November, 2017, at 7.00 p.m., Townspeople are invited to attend the Community Carol Service at the Parish Church of St Bartholomew. The Rotary Sleigh and Father Christmas will be present and Primary School choirs will perform Carols. At 8.00 p.m., the Town Mayor, Cllr Miss Samantha Watkin, will light the Christmas Tree and displays from outside the church and then refreshments will be served.
