

DANGEROUS WILD ANIMALS ACT 1976

The Act provides that no person shall keep any dangerous wild animal except under authority of a licence granted by the Council. A "dangerous wild animal" is defined as any animal which is specified in the Schedule to the Act.

APPLICATION FOR A LICENCE TO KEEP DANGEROUS WILD ANIMALS

NB: It is a requirement of the Act that the premises must be inspected and reported on to the Local Authority by their nominated Veterinary Surgeon as to the condition of the animals and the suitability of the accommodation.

The granting of a licence is dependent upon an inspection by an officer of the Local Authority together with a fire safety inspection and veterinary inspection if considered appropriate.
