
Bolton's Future Talent Scheme

Free leisure facility access for talented sports performers

Aim

Bolton's Future Talent Scheme (BFTS) will provide talented performers in Bolton with free access to a range of high quality local sports facilities.

The scheme is designed to ensure that effective support is offered to the borough's existing and future talented sports men and women. The ultimate desire is that promising young athletes from Bolton will be supported to achieve the goal of competing at national level. The scheme will assist elite local athletes to achieve their full potential by reducing the financial burden of training costs.

The scheme is open to athletes at any age residing in Bolton and will provide support for county/regional performers with the potential to compete at national level in any Sport England recognised sport.

The scheme is supported by all local partners in Bolton who are committed to raising participation and standards in sport locally.

The scheme will be administered by Bolton Sport and Physical Activity Alliance (BoSPAA) who aim to ensure strong local partnerships exist and local sporting aspirations are developed and achieved.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the scheme you must demonstrate that:

- you are a Bolton resident
- you have represented the county/region in the last 12 months
- your National Governing Body (NGB) believes you are capable of achieving National recognition







How Bolton's Future Talent Scheme (BFTS) will work

Talented Performers will be entitled to use any of the leisure centres from the list attached. You need to nominate a 'Home' venue for monitoring purposes. Each centre varies in what it offers members and some may impose restrictions, but this will be confirmed on acceptance of the scheme. Facilities must also be used in accordance with the centre's conditions.

The membership to the scheme is renewable on an annual basis providing you still meet the required criteria.

In return for the benefits of BTFS membership, Bolton Sport and Physical Activity Alliance (BoSPAA) and participating facilities can use the scheme as a promotional tool and members are asked to assist in promotional events whenever possible, reasonable and appropriate.

A range of other individual funding opportunities exist for talented performers in Bolton who are competing at county/regional level and have potential to compete at national level. These include BoSPAA.
