3,514 referrals to the **NHS Veterans' Mental Health Transition Intervention and Liaison Service** for treating Veterans' mental health.

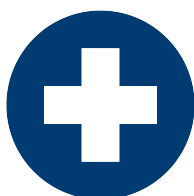
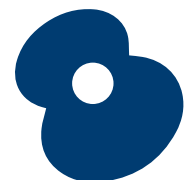

Covenant Fund Trust awarded 2,600 grants to World War I community projects.

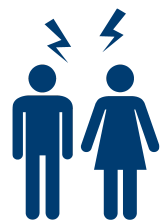
