Early Years SEN Inclusion Fund



What is it?

The Early Years SEN Inclusion Fund consists of different levels of packages of funding and training that can be accessed by settings, childminders and schools to support children with Special Educational Needs.

The funding can be used to improve children's outcomes in their learning through direct adult interventions. The training supports key members of staff working with those children to develop their skills and knowledge to offer opportunities for children to learn and progress in their learning.

What are the criteria for applying for these packages?

The Inclusion fund is available to children aged 2, 3 and 4 years old. The child must be attending a setting, school or childminder. This is for children who are in receipt of the Early Education Funding. They will also have at least one external agency working with the child.

How do I apply?

The child's setting applies for the Inclusion Fund, to apply you will need:

- Child Information Form
- Child's Early Help Action Plan Assessment and Early Help Review forms
- Any external agency reports
- ASQ information
