1. INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND

1.1 Cabinet approved the investment of an additional £10m of capital funding into highway maintenance (CAB 592, July 2019). Each Ward has been nominally allocated an equal share of the funding to carry out priority schemes in their areas on local residential roads and footways (Unclassified Roads). The Council also included an additional £2m in the February budget that has been approved (ECMHT 394, August 2019) to be added to this funding to provide further funding to each Ward.

2. ISSUES

- 2.1 Targeted investment in all Classes of carriageway (A, B, C & Unclassified) has resulted in maintaining a steady level of deterioration in the highway network. It isn't improving overall on the Classified network (A, B & C roads) but the total percentage in need of immediate repair or known to be declining towards that also hasn't increased significantly. However, after several years of improvement of the worst roads on the U-class network reductions in capital investment over the last 3yrs has led to a marked deterioration. This situation was not helped by the winter of 2017/18 (Beast from the East), which caused significant damage across the highway asset.
- 2.2 The U-class network is mainly comprised of residential streets outside people's homes, which means their condition is a social issue as well as an asset management one. In the past, when additional funding has been available, it has generally been directed to this part of the network since it makes up the largest proportion of the overall length of the road managed by the Council. However, the size of this U-class network means that significant targeted investment is needed to realise an appreciable overall improvement.
- 2.3 The Cabinet has approved the budget noted in 1.1 above to prioritise investment in the borough at Ward level and following consultation with Ward Members and the Executive Cabinet Member a priority programme is now proposed.

3. MAIN BODY OF THE REPORT

- 3.1 The common usage of 'Pothole' covers a multitude of defects in the highway pavement structure. The public perception is generally to consider any deterioration where there is a loss of the surface to be a pothole that should be filled by the Council as Highway Authority. Most visible defects are initially cosmetic and do not constitute a liability for the Council. The primary purpose of what become classified as Urgent Repairs, Minor Works or planned wider Patching are to protect the Councils insurance position not substantive improvement to the overall fabric of the asset. Structural Maintenance, be it precautionary, protective or resurfacing are improvements to the condition of the asset that can be considered as investment for valuation purposes.
- 3.2 Following a period of severe winters, the 2012 national guidance Pothole Review was titled 'Prevention is Better than Cure'. The fundamental principle being if you can avoid potholes forming generally you can reduce their impact; be that structurally or importantly the public perception. This guidance still forms part of the actions to be demonstrated to provide evidence that a Highway Authority is improving and maintaining its asset management strategy to qualify for additional funding from the Department for Transport through the Incentive Fund (IF).
- 3.5 Detailed condition assessments for main (classified A, B & C roads) are all carried out independently to national standards. Local (U-class) have additional factors to add to the basic data collected for

this classification of road; to reflect a variety of risk indicators and support priority decisions. This method has been used effectively for several years.

4. OPTIONS

- 4.1 An extended programme for U-class roads that fit a defined set of engineering parameters has been produced, so Ward Members can identify those options that their residents would regard as priorities. Each Ward has had the highest ranked roads and footways detailed up to and beyond the value of funding available. This information was circulated individually to each Ward Member in a spreadsheet form.
- 4.2 The Highways & Engineering team supported by the Area Forum Co-ordinators have aimed to develop a unanimous or majority consensus with Ward Members so that engineering priority and local issues are balanced to ensure best value for money is achieved for the investment. Any options to look at innovative options for addressing deterioration have also been highlighted to give informed choices.
- 4.3 Proposals brought forward by Ward Members outside of the priority schemes identified in the previously approved programmes (and the further expanded priorities) have required specific approval by the Executive Cabinet Member Deputy Leader, in consultation with the Director of Place.
- 4.4 It is anticipated that careful planning of future work schedules will enable the additional work to be undertaken alongside the existing highway programmes. It is already standard practice that smaller schemes are packaged up with our Framework Contractors to provide better value and reduce individual overhead costs.
- 4.5 As additional survey information becomes available, or if risks become apparent on a road or footway, these will be built into the rank priority in an area so that the forward programme can be kept live and be ready for any future investment strategy.
- 4.6 Following approval of the Ward programmes included in Appendix 1 & 2 (Carriageways & Footways) construction programmes will be developed to deliver the schemes and Ward Members will be kept informed of progress.

6. EIA

7. CONSULTATION

- 7.1 A full Member briefing was held on 22nd July to outline the process and to explain the aims of the project and the criteria for arriving at the priority of potential projects.
- 7.2 Costed options were provided to each Ward for further discussion and feedback (as noted in para 4.1). Including taking on board and assessing locally identified schemes to be included if appropriate within the priority criteria (noted in para 4.3).
- 7.3 A final proposed list of projects supported by Ward Members has then been submitted to the Executive Cabinet Member for review and inclusion in a final programme to be approved by Cabinet.

8. <u>VISION 2030</u>

The highways of Bolton, together with the associated bridges, structures, lighting and all other related equipment represents the Council's most valuable asset. It is estimated to be worth £1,260 million.

Maintaining this asset in good condition and fit for purpose is essential for the well being of those who live, work, invest and visit Bolton. Having a well maintained and efficient highway network helps to encourage inward investment, aid the transport of people and goods within, across and beyond the borough, while an attractive highway network can assist in improving the environment for local communities and improve the quality of life.

The Highways Asset Management Plan sets out detailed information that aims to assist in the future management, maintenance and improvement of the borough's highway network. The systematic approach to the management of the highway network will ensure that essential maintenance and improvements are carried out in a timely manner, making best use of financial resources and will help to demonstrate to Central Government and the Council Tax payers of Bolton that value for money is being achieved.

9. **RECOMMENDATIONS**
