

**BOLTON COUNCIL**  
**Statutory Notice for a proposed enlargement of Gaskell CP School.**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Bolton Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to enlarge Gaskell CP School, Thomas Holden Street, Bolton. BL1 2QG.

Bolton Council is proposing to enlarge Gaskell CP by physically extending the school and raising its Planned Admission Number from 45 to 60 with effect from 1st September 2020 for all year groups from Reception to Year 6, creating an additional 105 pupil places.

In September 2019 the school offered an additional 105 pupils across all year groups as a temporary increase, but the Council are now proposing to make this increase permanent.

The current number of pupils (Reception to Year 6) on roll at the school is 375 and the current physical capacity of the school is 315, excluding temporary modular classrooms that were recently provided. The Council is proposing to increase the school's capacity to 420 pupils, making Gaskell CP School a two form entry school.
