- 1. Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Bolton ("the Council") intends to extend the above Public Spaces Protection Order under Section 60 of the Anti-Social, Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act") for a period of three years from 20th October 2020.
- 2. The Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds that doing so is necessary to prevent:
 - a. occurrence or recurrence of the activities identified in the order, and / or
 - b. an increase in the frequency or seriousness of those activities

after the expiry of the existing order on 20th October 2020.

- 3. The Proposed Order relates to Alcohol Consumption in Public Places inside the borders of the Borough of Bolton as specified within the Order and Order Plan (The Restricted Area). The Order specifies the control of the consumption of alcohol within the Restricted Area at all times.
