

OUR AIMS ARE:

- ◆ To provide a continuing education for pupils who are out of school for medical reasons.
- ◆ To provide an education of similar quality to that available in school, including a broad and balanced curriculum
- ◆ To offer a minimum of 5 hours education per week in line with Government legislation.
- ◆ To promote your child's successful return to school.

THE SERVICE IS FOR:

- ◆ Pupils resident in Bolton and normally on the roll of a school.
- ◆ Pupils who are expected to be in hospital for five school days or more, OR to be at home through illness for more than three weeks.

We are a short term provision. Our aim is to return pupils to their mainstream school as soon as possible.

PARENTS GUIDE

THE HOSPITAL/HOME TEACHING SERVICE will:

- ◆ Liaise with the child's school
- ◆ Mark work where appropriate
- ◆ Provide reports to the child's school detailing the work covered and attendance.
- ◆ Return completed work

We may have to review the support your child receives if any of the following occur on three successive occasions or on more than four occasions in any four week period:

- ◆ There is no one at home when the teacher calls
- ◆ The teaching session is cancelled for no valid reason
- ◆ The child refuses to co-operate
- ◆ The environment is unsuitable for effective teaching and learning.

The service may be withdrawn if there are concerns that the ill health does not appear to be genuine OR supporting medical evidence cannot be provided.

In accordance with Bolton Council's Smoke-Free Policy we would request that you refrain from smoking and ventilate the room for at least 30 minutes before the teacher arrives .

YOU CAN HELP BY:



- ◆ Agreeing to share relevant medical information about your child.
- ◆ Notifying the Service as soon as possible if there is any reason for the visit to be cancelled.
- ◆ Making sure that a responsible adult stays in the house whilst your child is receiving tuition.

ALSO BY:

- ◆ Having the child ready for the teacher's arrival by providing somewhere appropriate to work and by making sure books, pens and pencils are to hand.
- ◆ Allowing the child to work without any unnecessary interruption or noise.
- ◆ Supporting the teacher by encouraging the child to work.
- ◆ Making sure that the work left with the child is attempted.
- ◆ Keeping all animals away from the teaching area.

THE SERVICE OFFERED:

Is a continuation of the National Curriculum entitlement in English, maths, PSHCEE and science, together with other subjects, where possible.



PLEASE NOTE:

EVERY child admitted to the Hospital / Home Teaching Service will undergo a service review on a regular basis. Their need for home tuition will be reassessed at this review.
