Update on Area Forum Budgets for Little Lever & Darcy Lever Ward – 3 May 2023

All ward budgets were consolidated in April 2022 following the redesign of the area working service. Each ward continued to receive a flat rate budget of £15,000 for financial years 20/21 and 21/22. All allocations since they were last published in December 2020 are listed below under a consolidated budget (approvals have been made under the Council's Scheme of Delegation).
