The Parade will assemble outside the St Bartholomew's Primary School yard, The Fairways, Westhoughton at 9.20 a.m. and will depart at 9.40 a.m. for a service at the Parish Church of St Bartholomew at 10.00 a.m., followed by a Service of Remembrance and the wreath laying at the War Memorial and a Parade.

Nominees must be under 30 years inclusive and have provided service to Westhoughton in any field. They do not have to be residents of Westhoughton to qualify. PLANTERS ON MARKET STREET

PRETORIA PIT DISASTER ANNIVERSARY

Tuesday, 21st December, 2021 is the 111th anniversary of the Pretoria Pit Disaster in which 344 men and boys lost their lives. Services of Remembrance will be held at 7.40 a.m. at the Pretoria Pit Disaster Centenary Memorial, Ditchfield Garden, with maroons fired at 7.50 a.m., which was the time of the explosion, and at 10.00 a.m., at the Parish Church of St Bartholomew, followed by the laying of floral tributes at the Pretoria Monument.
