Applying for a Charity Street Collection



If you would like to collect money or sell items for charity on the street you will require a street collection permit. Please see below some information to help you in applying for your collection:

Can I apply?

In order to apply for a charity street collection in Bolton, you must be registered with the Charities Commission and/or be a charitable organisation based within the Borough of Bolton. Due to restrictions on the number of collections held within the Bolton area, each charity is permitted one collection, per year, per area.

When to apply

As charitable applications go through a series of procedures to ensure the validity of the collection, the earlier the better. You must give at least 28 days notice. Please note you can only apply for your collections singularly (one at a time)

How to apply

Completing the attached form and emailing your application to <u>licensing.unit@bolton.gov.uk</u>. Forms and guidance are also available via the Downloads tab on the webpage

What information to provide

- Please complete all sections of the form fully
- If you are applying for a Street Collection where you have not collected in the Bolton area previously—you will also be required to submit the below with your application
 - \Rightarrow Literature about the organisation;
 - ⇒ Copy of published accounts for the last two years;
 - ⇒ Copy of statement of accounts from the last three or four collections carried out (including collections held in other Licensing Authority areas);
 - ⇒ Letter from the charitable organisation authorising you to undertake a collection on their behalf, if you are not an official of the charitable organisation; and
 - An agreement or contract details with any registered charity or individual benefiting from this collection.
- Details of where you intend to collect.
- The name, address and qualification of who will sign your returns form

What happens next?

If any further information is required from you, you will be contacted in due course by a Licensing Officer. The application, once completed, is reviewed once approved a permit and return form will be issued.

During my collection

As the applicant, you are considered the 'promoter' of the collection. You must ensure that each collector is a good and responsible person over the age of 16 years, that all relevant by-laws are adhered to by all persons involved in the collection and that the monies are handled and returned in a safe and fair way.

After my collection

You must submit your return form within one month following your collection. Once the form has been submitted, you may then book a further collection in the Bolton area. Kindly note, each organisation is permitted one collection per year in each area.
