Frequently Asked Questions

1) What are substance misuse services?

Substance misuse services provide support to people who are concerned about their / someone else's use of substances. This could be alcohol, illicit drugs, medication, or any other substance which is causing a problem.

2) Who provides substance misuse services in Bolton?

Bolton Council is responsible for ensuring there is support available for Bolton residents who need support for substance use. The Council currently commissions Greater Manchester Mental Health NHS Foundation Trust to provide a substance misuse service called **Achieve Bolton**.

Under-18s can get support at the **360 Service** delivered by Bolton NHS Foundation Trust.
