Notice of Application for a Full Variation to an existing Premises Licence

Punch Partnerships (PTL) Limited made an application to Bolton Council for a variation to the premises licence for:

Duke of Wellington, 60 St Johns Road, Bolton, BL6 4HA

The details of the variation applied for are as follows:

Extend the opening hours to 08:00 Monday-Friday for non-licensable activities.

Extend the start time for the sale of alcohol on Friday to Sunday to 09:00

Remove certain existing Annex 2 conditions and add a new conditions

The application may be inspected at Bolton Council Licensing Team, 1st floor, Bolton Town Hall, Bolton, BL1 1RU between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on Monday to Friday inclusive. Please note - during the current COV-19 arrangements access to the Town Hall has been restricted. Any 'Interested Party' or 'Responsible Authority' may make representations to the Council regarding the application during the period of 28 consecutive days starting with the day after the application was lodged with the Council, that day being 29.06.22. The last day for representations to be made will therefore be 27.07.22. All representations **must** be made in writing. Please note – during the current COV-19 arrangements all representation must be sent to the Licensing Team electronically, the email address is provided above.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application. On summary conviction, the maximum penalty for such an offence is an unlimited fine.
