To note - There are no local council elections planned to take place in 2025 so schools do not need to allocate an occasional day for the purpose of facilitating a polling station. However, if an election is postponed (as in the instance of Covid in 2020/2021) the election would likely take place on Thursday 1st May 2025. (If the school is used as a polling station and the school is required to close to facilitate the electoral duties of the polling station then one of the occasional days should be allocated to this closure.) Please bear in mind that occasional days may need to be reallocated to cover this in the rare event of an election being postponed/rescheduled.
