- 2. The Definitive Map for the Borough Council of Bolton (relevant date 25th April 1984) and its associated Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to this Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Bolton (Public Footpath No. 516 Bolton) Definitive Map Modification Order (2) 2014.

PART 1

MODIFICATION OF THE DEFINITIVE MAP

Description of path to be added

A public footpath commencing from a point on the access road to Edditch Farm (an unadopted highway), off Hengist Street, Bolton, at (Point A on the Order Plan) at Grid Reference SD 373391 409123 and running for a distance of 48 metres in a generally north to south direction to join an existing path within Leverhulme Park at (Point D on the Order Plan) at Grid Reference SD 373397 409079 over a hard surface from Point A to Point C, at Grid Reference SD 373395 4090098 and a foot trodden surface from Point C to Point D. At a width of 3.96 metres at (Point A on the Order Plan) at Grid Reference SD 373391 409123 decreasing to 2.7 metres at (Point B on the Order Plan) at Grid Reference SD 373394 409106 continuing from (Point B to C to D on the Order Plan) with a width of 2.7 metres ending with (Point D on the Order) Plan at Grid Reference SD 373398 409079 and shown as a continuous line with short bars at intervals on the Order Plan.

MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE STATEMENT

The Definitive Statement is amended by the addition of the following entries:

The path has a varying width over its length from 3.96 metres to 2.7 metres

A gate Limitations: An existing gate is present across the whole width at Point A (on the Order Plan) and and existing gate is present which limits the width to 0.9 metres at (Point C on the Order Plan) at Grid Reference SD 373395 409098.
