This account relates to summer bedding in the planters and hanging baskets in the town centre.

About 10 years ago the planter and rail toughs in the town centre were funding either by Westhoughton Area Forum or Town Centre Funding, the bill for the flowers was then picked by Westhoughton Town Council.

The Town Council covered the costs of the hanging baskets in 2021 after a cut by Bolton Council.

Early this year the town council decided that the quality of the hanging baskets was poor for the cost of over £4000 that the council would not proceed in 2022. This was remove from the 2022/2023 budget

Cllr Speight informed council that a volunteer group could take over the planting of the planters.

Bolton Council assumed that Westhoughton Town Council would pay for the planting; there was no consultation or request made to the town council and no request made by the town council.
