- James Copper asked about the Westhoughton Town Centre CCTV scheme. He was informed verbally that these car parks are under the control of Bolton Council and are not covered by cameras owned by Westhoughton Town Council. As additional information, Bolton Council has been contacted regarding the recent damaged cars and they have replied to say that they are happy for the Town Council to expand CCTV coverage to the car parks, but would provide no funding toward this. The issue of CCTV and the possibility of improving the current system will be an agenda item for Monday 12 June.
- Alvis Younge asked about the death of deer by collision with vehicles and whether this is an issue Bolton Council's Planning Department takes into consideration on planning matters. This question will be referred to Bolton's Planning Department.
