# Don't receive one of the listed benefits? Don't worry!...

Next Energy work with the Greater Manchester Combined Authority who may be able to deem you eligible, even if you are not in receipt of one of these benefits.

#### What is ECO?

The Energy Company Obligation (ECO) scheme is a government backed initiative aimed at improving the energy efficiency rating of thousands of homes across Great Britain and reducing homeowners' energy bills. Since 2013, energy companies have funded over 3.6 million different measures through the scheme, such as wall insulation, new heating systems, and renewables. The government plans to spend approximately £1 billion per year on the scheme until 2026.

#### Do I qualify?

If your home has an EPC (Energy Performance Certificate) rating of D-G, then you may! We can check your home's rating and help to determine it if your home does not currently have one.

Customer eligibility is outlined on the next page; however, Next Energy also work with several councils across the North West to help you qualify even if you do not receive one of the listed benefits.

This scheme is open to homeowners and tenants living in both privately rented and social housing.
