School Admissions 2025 - 2026 Frequently Asked Questions



1) What changes are being proposed?

It is being proposed that waiting lists for in year admissions (children changing school during the year) are only held for one term at a time rather than for the whole academic year. It is also proposed that parents will need to request their child be added to a waiting list rather than automatically being placed on the waiting list.

2) When are these changes proposed for?

If agreed, these changes will be with effect from September 2024 onwards.

3) Why are these changes being proposed?

When waiting lists are held for the entire year they become quite long and the reality for many children is that they will not gain a place at their preferred school from the waiting list. This gives parents unrealistic expectations and false hope.

The majority of children who are offered places from waiting lists do already have a school place in Bolton. When they are offered a place from a waiting list, that place is held for them whilst starting arrangements are made, during which time they continue to attend their original school. During this intervening period, they are taking up two school places. These pattern is then repeated when we try to fill the place they have vacated. This makes it difficult to offers places to children without a school place.

Many children move school only a short distance due to being on multiple waiting lists. This 'school-hopping' is de-stabilising for schools, impacting on class teachers and school funding, as well as impacting both the child concerned and the class of children they are leaving or arriving to.

Reducing the number of children on waiting lists and the time they are held for will mean that places can be offered quicker to pupils that are unplaced, and will mean more stability for schools and children.

4) Are all schools affected by this change?

No. Some schools have chosen to continue with the current waiting list policy. A full list of schools who are affected by these changes is available at the end of this document.

5) Does this change affect waiting lists for children moving from nursery to primary school, or from year 6 to year 7?

No, this change only affects in year admissions. This is those children that are wanting to change schools during the school year, or children who are moving into Bolton and require a place in a Bolton school.

6) How will parents be able to request their child be placed on a waiting list?

An online response form will be provided for parents to indicate that they wish their child to be placed on a waiting list for a school. Details of this will be provided to parents when their child is refused a place at a school.

7) How will waiting lists be prioritised?

Waiting lists will continue to be prioritised by the individual admission criteria for each school.

8) Will parents be reminded that the waiting list is ending at the end of term?

In the initial response to their application, parents will be informed that they can request their child's name to be placed on a waiting list until the end of that term, and they will be given the date that applies for that term. No other reminders will be sent.

9) How do I keep my child's name on a waiting list after the end of a term?

If after a waiting list ends, you still wish for your child to be on the waiting list for a school, you would need to submit a new application for that term. No reminders will be sent, it will be the parents responsibility to do this.
