The Council intends to make an order which will enable the following events to take place in Horwich on dates as indicated:

#### **RIVINGTON PIKE FELL RACES**

Between approximately 2.45pm and 4.15pm on Saturday 30 March, Lever Park Avenue will be closed from Scholes Bank to Dryfield Lane.

The alternative route for traffic will be Scholes Bank - Dryfield Lane.

#### A DAY FOR ST GEORGE

Between approximately 12.30pm and 2pm on Saturday 20 April, Brownlow Road will be closed from Lee Lane for approximately 30m in a north-easterly direction (the area of carriageway adjacent to the Saddle Public House).

The alternative route for traffic will be Lee Lane, Longworth Rd, Beaumont Rd, Brownlow Rd.
