- Complete enteric outbreak log sheet details of cases, onset, symptoms / stool type (Bristol stool chart)
- Stool Testing obtain only if directed to via GP / CIPCT
- Suspend transfers / admissions dependant on risk assessment with CIPCT
- Isolate symptomatic residents to their room (if safe to do so) otherwise consider cohorting with other symptomatic residents in a seperate area, until 72 hours clear of symptoms (48 hours for staff)
- Visiting can continue however visitors must be informed of the outbreak and potential risk. Consider limiting visits for those who are symptomatic. Ensure visitors have access to hand washing facilities / PPE
- Encourage frequent Hand Hygiene residents, staff & visitors wash hands with liquid soap /running warm water (alcohol gel is ineffective for enteric viruses)
- Enhanced cleaning (minimum twice daily) with chlorine based solutions (dilution of 1,000 parts per million) to include all communal areas, especially high touch surfaces
- PPE Disposable gloves and aprons when providing personal care / handling bodily fluids. Doning and doffing correctly and disposed appropriately in affected residents' rooms
- Laundry Handle soiled linen with PPE. Water soluble or machine washable 'red' bags must be available in affected residents rooms
- Lifting outbreak restrictions should be agreed with CIPCT
- Deep clean of the home including all affected and communal areas is recommended prior to reopening
