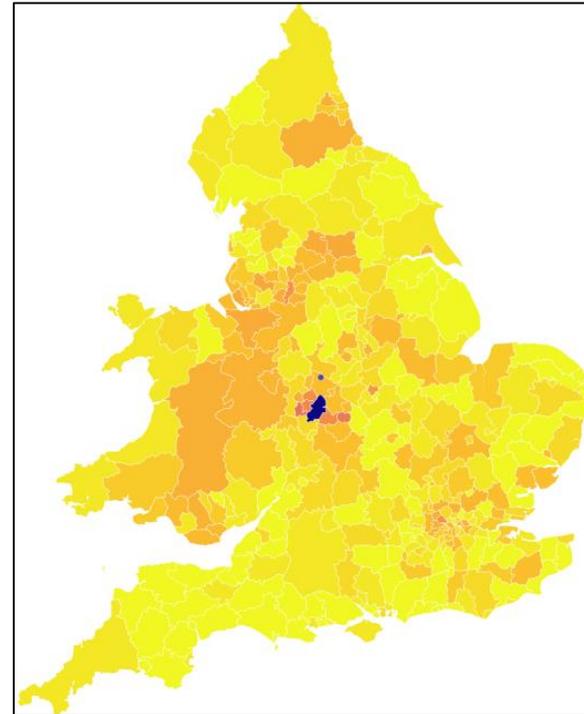

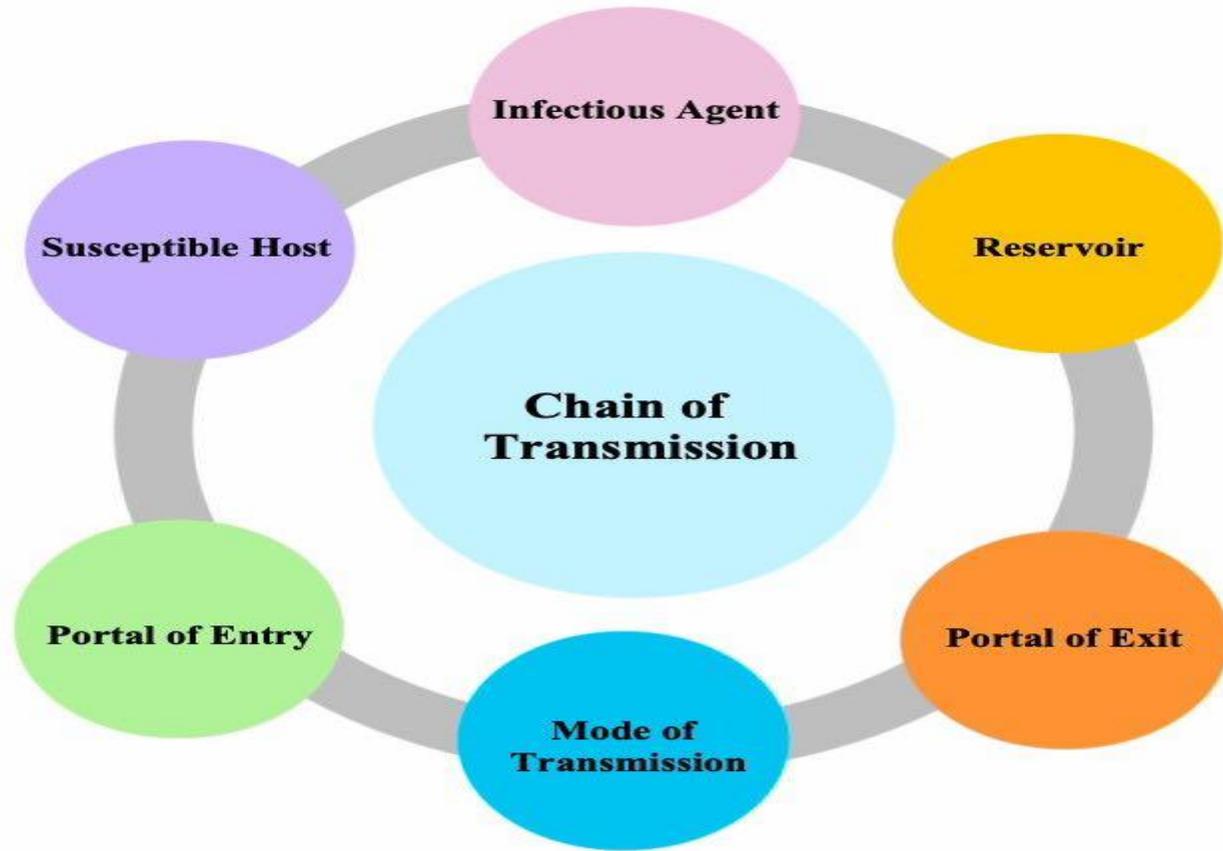
# Update – outbreaks & emerging infections

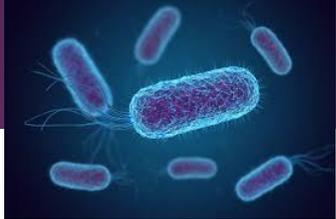
- ▶ COVID-19 –

# IPC Audit in Care Homes

- ▶ IPC Audits provide an opportunity to assess current IPC practices within the care home that prevent and manage infections.
- ▶ They also help to identify any areas where improvement may be required
- ▶ The audit is 100% supportive – we are not there to point fingers!
- ▶ On average, audits are undertaken every 12-18 months



# Audit Process



- ▶ A phone call or email is sent to the home to arrange a suitable date / time for the IPC audit. The audit is performed by one or two CIPC Nurses.
- ▶ Generally it takes 1.5 – 2.5 hrs. and it would be expected for a senior representative to accompany when reviewing the environment / documentation.
- ▶ Any specific issues would generally be discussed at the time of the audit.
- ▶ On completion, the report is written up usually within 2 weeks and sent back to the home & QAT with RAG rating and recommended actions
- ▶ Normally we expect a response back with update on actions is within 3 months – though this may be less if there are more immediate actions

## RAG Rating Percentages

**0% to 70% = Red**

**71% to 91% = Amber**

**92% to 100% = Green**
