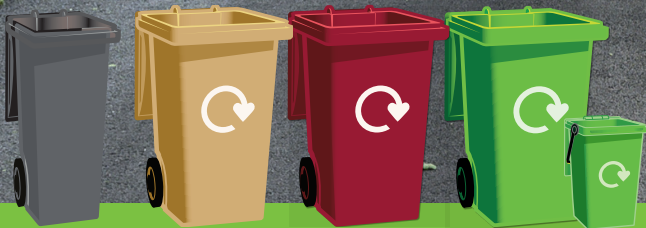

Key reminders to help you manage your bins:

- Leave your bins out by 7am on your collection day.
- Make sure your waste fits inside the bins with the lids fully closed and they are not too heavy to move.
- Do not place non-recyclable material in your recycling bins (see next page) as the collection team will not be able to empty them.
- Once emptied, please return your bin to your property as soon as possible.
- Put your house number on your bin to reduce the risk of theft.

Bolton Council carries out over **11 million** bin collections per year



49.5% of waste collected in Bolton was recycled during 2022/23 (which is above the national average)

Your waste is your responsibility

All household waste presented for collection must be contained within your bin. Loose or bagged rubbish placed on the pavement will be considered flytipping and not be collected by the council.

If you don't dispose of your rubbish correctly you could be issued with a fixed penalty fine or face prosecution.

Your local recycling centres

Any items that cannot go in your bins can be brought to a waste and recycling centre in Bolton.
