



- 1. The Interpretation Act 1978, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 2. The Bolton (Regulation of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (Consolidation) Order 2015, means the Bolton (Regulation of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (Consolidation) Order 2015, or as that (Consolidation) Order 2015, re-made or re-consolidated.
- 3. The Bolton (Regulation of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (Consolidation) Order 2015, shall have the effect as though the sides of lengths of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order were deleted from Schedule 3 to that Order.
- 4. The Bolton (Regulation of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (Consolidation) Order 2015, shall have the effect as though the sides of lengths of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order were included in Schedule 3 to that Order.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on the XX and may be cited as The Bolton (Regulation of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (Consolidation) Order 2015 (Paderborn Way Development), Bolton) (Amendment) (No. XX) Order 2025.

THE BOLTON (MOVING TRAFFIC ORDER) (BLACKHORSE STREET (PADERBORN WAY DEVELOPMENT), BOLTON) (NO.XX) ORDER 2025

The Borough Council of Bolton, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) 81, 82, 83 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act) and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Greater Manchester Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby makes the following Order:-

1. In this Order

"Road" has the same meaning as defined in Section 142(1) (a) of the Act;

"Vehicle" has the same meaning as defined in Section 1(1B) of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994;

"Restricted road" has the same meaning as defined in Section 82 of the Act;

"cyclist" means a person on a pedal cycle.

"emergency services vehicle" means a vehicle operated by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance service

"motor vehicle" means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads, by mechanical power;

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs and General Directions 2016.

- The Bolton (Barn Street and Blackhorse Street, Bolton) (One Way Traffic) (No. 2)
 Order 2012 shall have the effect as though the sides of lengths of road specified in
 Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order were deleted from the Schedule Part 2 to that
 Order.
- 3. The Bolton (Coronation Street, Bolton) (One Way Traffic) (No.12) Order 2014 shall be revoked in its entirety.
- 4. The County Borough of Bolton (Howell Croft South) (Spring Gardens) (Back Spring Gardens) (Cheadle Square) (Prohibition of Driving) Orders, 1969 shall have the effect as though the prohibition of driving restriction for Cheadle Square (From its junction with Blackhorse Street for a distance of 5 yards (4.5m) in an easterly direction) was deleted from that order.
- 5. The Bolton (Bus Lanes and Bus Gateways) (Consolidation) Order 2015, shall have the effect as though the sides of lengths of road specified in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order were deleted from Schedule 3 to that Order.
- 6. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 mph in the lengths of road specified in Part 3 of the Schedule to this Order.
- 7. The speed limit imposed by this Order does not apply to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and

- Amendment) Regulations 2011, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
- 8. All vehicles proceeding along Market Egress Road, on reaching its junction with Blackhorse Street must, except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform or with the permission of a police officer in uniform will turn left at the junction as specified in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order. Nothing in this article 8 shall render it unlawful for an emergency services vehicle to proceed contrary to this order in an emergency.
- 9. No person, shall except with the permission or the direction of a police officer in uniform, cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed in that part of the road specified in columns 1 and 2 to the Schedule Part 5 to this Order at any time other than:
 - a. A vehicle being used in the course of an emergency by emergency services vehicles
 - b. pedal cycles
- 10. Nothing in Article 9 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from using or causing or permitting any motor vehicle to proceed in the length of road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used (if it cannot reasonably be used for the same purpose in any other road):
 - c. In connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, apparatus for the supply of gas, water electricity or telecommunication
 - d. In the service of a local authority or highway authority or their authorised contractors, in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
 - e. In the service of a statutory body or undertaker in pursuance of their statutory powers or duties.
- 11. Save as provided in Article 12 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable or a police community support officer in uniform, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule Part 6 to this Order, in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road specified in column 3 of the Schedule Part 6 to this Order.
- 12. Nothing in Article 11 of this Order, shall render it unlawful to cause an emergency services vehicle, or any vehicle used in the service of a fire and rescue authority or police force, to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule Part 6 of this Order, during an emergency.
- 13. The provisions of this article 11 and 12 of this order shall not be applicable to cyclists.
- 14. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any other Order relating to the one way movement of traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule Part 6 of this Order, this Order shall prevail.

- 15. The provisions of paragraphs 6, 8, ,9 and 11 shall not apply to an emergency services vehicle, where to do so would be likely to hinder the use of the vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used.
- 16. Where road or property names have been changed following reclassification, renaming or numbering, the descriptive names within the Order may be changed without changing the effect of the Order and without the need for re-publication.
- 17. For the avoidance of doubt, where a length of road is described within the Schedule to this Order, that restriction unless stated to the contrary within the schedule to this Order shall apply to the whole width of the road so described and in all directions along those said lengths of road including footway and verges.
- 18. Any reference in this Order to a road by its name shall be construed as a reference to the road in the Borough bearing the name as identified and defined in the Borough Council of Bolton document 'The Highway Register' in accordance with Section 36(6) of the Highways Act 1980.
- 19. This Order will become operative on the XXX and may be cited as The Bolton (Moving Traffic Order) (Blackhorse Street (Paderborn Way Development), Bolton) (No.Xx) Order 2025.
