From Monday 30 June 2025 to Friday 8 August 2025, at the request of a local government elector, the Auditor must give the elector or any representative of the elector an opportunity to question the Auditor about the accounting records of the Council. From Monday 30 June 2025 to Friday 8 August 2025 a local government elector for the area of the Council or his/her representative may object to the Council's accounts as set out in sections 26 and 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. Written notice of the proposed objection and the grounds on which it will be made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above and also copied to the Council at the address given below. Any objection must state the grounds on which the objection is being made and particulars of:

- a) Section 28 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 namely to apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law; and/or
- b) Any matter in respect of which it is proposed that the Auditor could make a public interest report under section 24 of and paragraph 1 of schedule 7 to the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014.
