

Update on Area Working Budgets for Bradshaw Ward – 1st April 2025 – 30th June 2025

As at the 1st April 2025, the Area Working Discretionary Budget available to Bradshaw ward was £26,698.02.

There was also a Growing the Good Work budget of £9,088.22 and a One-Off budget allocation of £147,110.00.
