

Update on Area Working Budgets for Westhoughton South Ward – 1st April 2025 – 30th June 2025

As at the 1st April 2025, the Area Working Discretionary Budget available to Westhoughton South was £12,828.32.

There was also a Growing the Good Work budget of £10,861 and a One-Off budget allocation of £145,110
