

Update on Area Working Budgets for Westhoughton North & Hunger Hill 1st April 2025 – 30th June 2025

As at the 1st April 2025, the Area Working Discretionary Budget available to Westhoughton Ward and Hunger Hill ward was £16,449.86.

There was also a Growing the Good Work budget of £18,891.00 and a One Off budget allocation of £135,110.00.
