Right to request wraparound childcare



Quality early years education and childcare in **Bolton**

As a parent or carer, you have the right to request wraparound childcare to support your family's needs. Wraparound childcare means before-and-after school.



Schools and local authorities are committed to working with parents to explore options for high quality, affordable and accessible childcare outside standard school hours.

How it works

Who can request?

Parents or carers of children in primary school.

What can you request?

Before school and after-school childcare such as breakfast clubs, plus childcare during term time and potentially during school holidays.


How to make a request

Contact your child's school or Bolton Families Information Service to express your interest.

Schools will assess demand and work with providers to develop suitable childcare options.

While schools are not legally required to provide wraparound childcare directly, they must consider parental demand and work towards solutions where possible.

Your request helps shape future childcare availability, so we encourage you to share your needs.
