

Update on Area Working Budgets for Westhoughton North & Hunger Hill 1st July 2025 – 30th September 2025

As at the 1st July 2025, the Area Working Discretionary Budget available to Westhoughton Ward and Hunger Hill ward was £14,969.86.

There was also a Growing the Good Work budget of £15,051.00 and a One Off budget allocation of £133,661.00.
