

## **Update on Area Working Budgets for Farnworth North Ward –1st October – 31<sup>th</sup> December 2025**

As at the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2025, the Area Working Discretionary Budget available to Farnworth North ward was £3,740.98.

There was also a Growing the Good Work Budget of £5,081.48 and a One-Off budget allocation of £71,356.66.
