

## **Licensing Act 2003 - Notice of Application for a Minor Variation to an existing Premises Licence**

Admiral Taverns Ltd has made an application for a variation to the premises licence for: Pineapple, 562 Blackburn Road, Bolton BL1 7AL

The details of the variation applied for are as follows:

to request an amendment to the conditions under Annex 2, point 2, Children in Bar –

We would like to remove the following - No person under fourteen shall be in the bar of the licensed premises during the permitted hours unless one of the following applies:

- a) He is the child of the holder of the premises licence.
- b) He resides in the premises but is not employed there.
- c) He is in the bar solely for the purpose of passing to or from some part of the premises which is not a bar and to or from which there is no other convenient means of access or egress.
- d) The bar is in railway refreshment rooms or other premises constructed, fitted and intended to be used bona fide for any purpose to which the holding of the licence is ancillary.

In this condition includes any place exclusively or mainly used for the consumption of alcohol. But an area is not a bar when it

is usual for it to be, and it is, set apart for the service of table meals and alcohol is only sold or supplied to persons as an ancillary to their table meals.

To be replaced with the following new proposed condition –

### **Proposed New Condition**

Children are permitted on the premises until 19:00. After 19:00, no person under the age of 18 may remain on the premises unless attending a private pre-booked function.

This application for a minor variation will not impact any of the licensable activities permitted by this current premises licence.

Any representations to the Council regarding the application to be made during the period of 10 consecutive days starting with the day after the application was lodged with the Council. The last day for representations to be made is 12 February 2026. All representations **must** be made in writing and **sent to the Licensing Team in writing or via email**
