

## **BOLTON HALF MARATHON TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES**

THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF BOLTON  
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION (SPECIAL EVENTS) ACT 1994

The Council will make an order, operative from 28 February 2026, to enable Bolton Half Marathon to take place. Active between approx 11pm on Saturday 28 February and 1pm on Sunday 1 March 2026, all vehicles not engaged in the event will be restricted as stated on the following streets:

White Lion Brow from its junction with Spa Road to its junction with Chorley Street.  
Chorley Street from its junction with White Lion Brow to its junction with Queens Park Walk.  
St Helena Road from its junction with White Lion Brow to its junction with Pool Street.  
St Edmund Street over its full length.  
Deansgate over its full length.  
Black Horse Street from its junction with Deansgate to its junction with Great Moor Street.  
Ashburner Street over its full length.  
Back Spring Gardens over its full length.  
Queen Street over its full length.  
Howell Croft South over its full length.  
Victoria Square South over its full length.  
Le Mans Crescent over its full length.  
Howel Croft North over its full length.  
Victoria Square North over its full length.  
Newport Street over its full length.  
Hotel Street from its junction with Victoria Street to it junction with Market Street.  
Market Street over its full length.  
Corporation Street from its junction with Market Street to its junction with Knowsley Street.  
Knowsley Street over its full length.  
Park Road from its junction with Gilnow Road to its junction with West Street.  
Seed Street over its full length.  
Back Spring Gardens full length

### **ONE-WAY TRAFFIC**

Park Road from Sterratt Street to Croal Street - Permitted direction of travel north-westerly

### **NO WAITING AT ANY TIME EXCEPT TAXIS**

*(08:00 until 13:00 on 1 March 2026 or at such time as the last competitor has passed this point)*

Bradshawgate - west side from a point 8 metres south of the extended southerly kerbline of Nelson Square (south of the gardens) to a point 18 metres north of the extended northerly kerbline of Great Moor Street.

Spa Road - Both sides over its full length.  
White Lion - Both sides over its full length.  
Chorley Street - Both sides from its junction with White Lion Brow to its junction with Queens Park Walk.

St Helena Road - Both sides from its junction with White Lion Brow to its junction with Pool Street.  
St Edmund Street - Both sides over its full length.  
Deansgate - Both sides over its full length.  
Blackhorse Street - Both sides from its junction with Deansgate to its junction with Great Moor Street.  
Ashburner Street - Both sides over its full length.  
Back Spring Gardens - Both sides over its full length.  
Queen Street - Both sides over its full length.  
Howell Croft South - Both sides over its full length.  
Victoria Square South - Both sides over its full length.  
Le Mans Crescent - Both sides over its full length.  
Howell Croft North - Both sides over its full length.  
Victoria Square North - Both sides over its full length.  
Newport Street - Both sides over its full length.  
Hotel Street - Both sides from its junction with Victoria Street to its junction with Market Street.  
Market Street - Both sides over its full length.  
Corporation Street - Both sides from its junction with Market Street to its junction with Knowsley Street.  
Knowsley Street - Both sides over its full length.  
Park Road - On the easterly side from its junction with Gilnow Road to its junction with West Street.  
Seed Street - Both sides over its full length.  
Park Road - Both sides from its junction with Sterratt Street to its junction with Croal Street.

## **SUSPENSION OF PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**


*(1 March 08:00 – 13:00)*
