ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 S.14


The Council intends to make an order, operative from 16 March 2026 between 9.30am and 3pm for 5 days approx., the effect of which will be to prohibit all traffic from proceeding on Lorne Street from Egerton St to Thynne St to allow resurfacing works to take place. Alternative route is via Campbell St, Cawdor St. The Order will end after 18 months or on completion of the works whichever first occurs.
