



Inspection during the term of the licence

Inspections of licensed premises

12.—(1) A local authority that has granted a primate licence

(a) may, during the licence period, arrange for a suitable person to inspect the premises specified in the licence to determine whether the licence conditions are being met

and


(b) must do so at least once in that period unless the licence was granted for a period of less than one year.

(2) An inspection under paragraph (1) must be carried out at a reasonable hour.

GUIDANCE

At least one inspection of the licensed premises by a suitable person is required during any licensing period. This does not apply where the licence is granted for a period of less than one year.
