

Update on Area Working Budgets for Heaton, Lostock & Chew Moor Ward – 1st January 2026 – 31st March 2026

As at the 1st January 2026, the Area Working Discretionary Budget available to Heaton, Lostock & Chew Moor ward was £2,110.99.

There was also a Growing the Good Work Budget of £10,100.00 and a One-Off allocation of £0.00.
