**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO EXTEND THE DOGS ON LEADS BY DIRECTION PUBLIC  
SPACES PROTECTION ORDER**

1. Notice is hereby given that the Borough Council of Bolton (“the Council”) intends to extend the above Public Spaces Protection Order under Section 60 of the Anti-Social, Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 (“the Act”) for a period of three years from 20th October 2026.
2. The Council is satisfied on reasonable grounds that doing so is necessary to prevent:
  - a. occurrence or recurrence of the activities identified in the order, and / or
  - b. an increase in the frequency or seriousness of those activities

after the expiry of the existing order on 19th October 2026.

3. The Proposed Order relates to properly supervising and controlling dogs in public spaces as specified on the Order and Order Schedule. This Order applies at all times to the land specified in the Schedule.
