PROPHET MUHAMMAD WALK 2026 – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES

The Council will make an order, operative between the hours of 1:45pm and 3:15pm on Sunday 23 August 2026 to enable the Prophet Muhammad Walk to safely take place. All vehicles not engaged in the event will be prohibited from proceeding on:

Grecian Crescent - from Rishton Lane to Northolt Drive
Rishton Lane - from Settle Street to Grecian Crescent
Settle Street - from Higher Swan Lane to Rishton Lane
Higher Swan Lane - from Bridgeman Street to Settle Street
Higher Swan Lane - from Bridgeman Street to Settle Street
Bridgeman Street - from High Street to Goldsmith Street
High Street - from Derby Street to Bridgeman Street
Bella Street – Full length

The walk will operate under a rolling roadblock with streets open to traffic once the parade has passed.

The order will cease to have effect at 4pm on 23 August 2026 or on completion of the event, whichever first occurs.
